## Field School Summary

The objectives of the Field School are to present water-related information that will be of lasting value to decision-makers, facilitate discussions and networking, and examine the application of science, law, and policy to water issues that presently face north-central Arizona regional, tribal, and local governments.

The Field School is being organized expressly for the benefit of elected municipal and tribal councils and county supervisors, who frequently are called upon to make decisions related to water use and management. However, other individuals who are interested in this focus and who would like to participate are welcome to register. As part of the Field School, we plan to identify and explore solutions to water issues that are of concern to this community.

During the Field School we will examine, both in work sessions and in field settings, water supply, storm water and flooding, and wastewater issues. We are planning presentations, a panel discussion, and group discussions on these topics. In addition, we will travel to highly-relevant locations in and around Flagstaff to gain a hands-on perspective on these issues.

By late May, you will receive a pre-workshop informational packet that includes papers and documents that will benefit your understanding and participation during the presentations and discussions.
